

From November 18 to December 2, Oregon will be in a statewide Two-Week Freeze. This will impact many industries and businesses including:

- CLOSURE OF: Indoor recreational facilities, museums, indoor entertainment activities, and indoor pools and sports courts
- CLOSURE OF: Zoos, gardens, aquariums, outdoor entertainment activities, and outdoor pools

Additionally, this requires that all restaurants will close their dine-in options and operate as take-out and delivery only.

During this freeze, some attractions may be partially accessible as follows:

Clatsop County Heritage Museum, Flavel House and Oregon Film Museum	Closed	Closed during the 2-week Freeze.
Columbia River Maritime Museum	Closed*	The Museum Store is open for shopping by appointment. Email anderson@crmm.org to set up a time.
Fort Stevens State Park Day Use Areas	Open Daily	Outdoor Day Use is generally open Dawn to Dusk Gate at Historic Area: open 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. (call to inquire about hours as they may change) The MUSEUM is closed. Beach accesses, trails, disc golf, batteries are open.
Hanthorn Cannery Museum	Open Daily	Self-guided exhibits at Pier 39 are accessible.
High Life Adventures Zip Line Park	Closed	Closed during the 2-week Freeze. Book reservations online for future tours.
Lewis & Clark NHP Fort Clatsop	Open Daily	Visitor Center and Fort Replica are CLOSED. Shop online: https://fortclatsopbookstore.com/ Netul Landing and trails open Dawn to Dusk Visitor Center parking gate open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.
