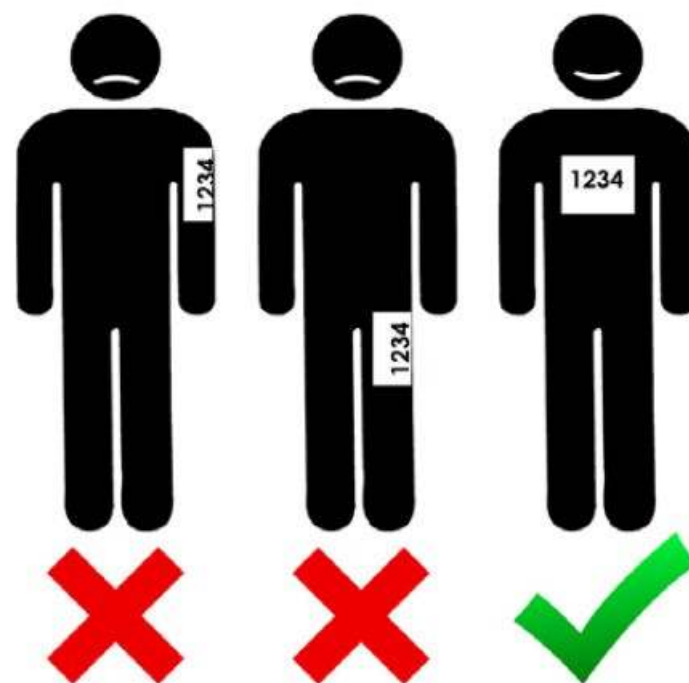


BIB PLACEMENT

WANT TO GET YOUR **RESULTS**?

If you have a chip attached to your race bib, do **NOT** remove it.

Leave the chip on the back of your race bib and pin your race bib on the front of your shirt or shorts.



WEAR YOUR BIB **CORRECTLY**!



CHECK YOUR BIB

The label on the front of your bib shows the information we have for you in our system.

Please make sure that these pertinent details are correct - they will affect your timing results.

Check the back of the bib to verify your emergency contact and phone number.



Front side:

Bib #: 1234 Gender / Age Zip Code
Last Name, First Name
Shirt option (if purchased)

Back side:

Your bib # and first name
Emergency contact name
Emergency contact phone number



NEED RELIEF?



Many portable toilets will be at the Starting Line!
2 portable toilets will be located on the bridge near mile marker 3.



RACE ETIQUETTE



Runners should start first,
followed by walkers in the back



WATER STATIONS



If you think you will need water on the bridge, you are encouraged to bring your own water bottle.

Water stations: at starting line, near mile 5, and at the finish line.

Water is not provided on the bridge because it is a state highway that promptly re-opens to traffic following the race, leaving no time to clean up trash left on the bridge.

DO NOT LEAVE TRASH ON OUR BEAUTIFUL BRIDGE.

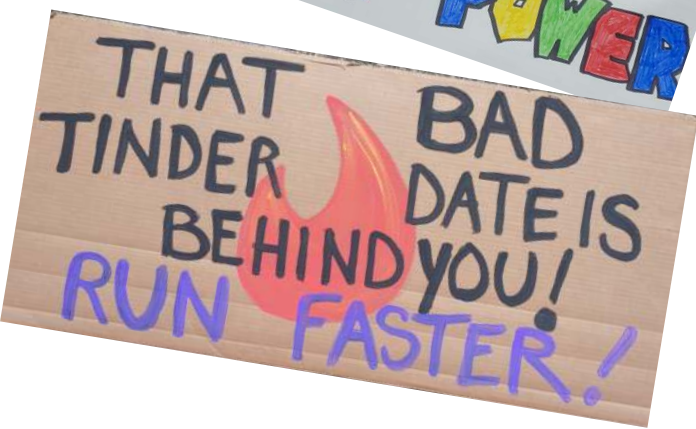

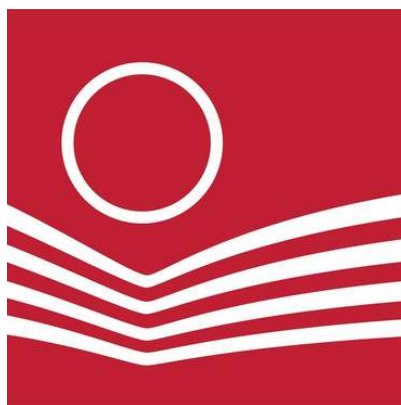
